Background

The Society for the Conversation of Nature of Liberia (SCNL) is a non-profit conservation organization in Liberia, working with government, international organizations, civil society organizations, Indigenous people, local communities, and the private sector for over 30 years helping to conserve nature.

Identification and description of SUSTAIN Project Activities

SUSTAIN-Sustainable Forest Conservation in Southeastern Liberia project targets the Sapu National Park, the Grebo Krahn National Park and the Proposed Kwa National Park landscape. Conservation project targets the protection of 6 unprotected areas of forest in the Gola Landscape including three communities' forest (Seekon-Pellekon, Seweajua and Konobo) which will serve as biodiversity corridor to the Proposed and National Parks in the Southeastern Liberia with the following goals:

Key Responsibilities

- Drive safely and carefully, observing the speed limits and traffic rules in accordance to road conditions in urban and rural settings
- Ensure that the assigned vehicle is clean and road worthy at all times, equipped with necessary spare parts, and tools (jack, spare tires, bulbs, etc)
- Check the vehicle condition and maintain the Log Book as required

- Drive SUSTAIN/SCNL vehicle only for the transport of authorized personnel and delivery
